#### **ACKNOWLEDGEMENT**

APAN and AMAN acknowledge that we live and work on unceded First Nations lands. We acknowledge the dispossession and ongoing harm done to Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples by colonisation, and we are inspired by their fight for recognition, rights, culture, and self-determination. We acknowledge the Country of the Jagera, Toorbul, Wurundjeri, Bunurong, Gadigal, Ngunnawal and Whadjak Noongar people, on which we work and live. We pay our respect to the Elders of those lands, both past and present, and their role as custodians of these lands. This land always was and always will be Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander land because sovereignty has never been ceded. We recognise the role of the colonial legal system in establishing, entrenching, and continuing the oppression and injustice experienced by First Nations peoples. We pledge to work to undo this in solidarity.

#### INTRODUCTION

We acknowledge that racism has a long history in Australia, originating at its inception from invasion towards Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples. The colonial logic under which Australian systems and institutions still operate today is a key driving force behind Australia's participation in the oppression of all Palestinians, as well as the indifference and other acts of racist violence experienced by Palestinians, Arabs and Muslims in Australia outlined in this paper. We believe that accountability for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples would critically transform this country's culture of racism, leading to a fairer and more just society for all.

This report sheds light on the manifestations of anti-Palestinian and anti-Muslim racism within a large public Australian Facebook group, identifying as a Jewish group. To some Jewish peers who have reviewed earlier drafts of this report, this group can be more accurately described as a Zionist or pro-Israel group.

The content in this group does not reflect views that are intrinsic to being Jewish or practising Judaism at all, and in fact are a cause of deep concern and offence to many Jewish Australians.

While this report cannot make any claims about prevalence, it does indicate a disturbing pattern of conduct within a significant Zionist group to tolerate racism, hatred and dehumanisation directed at Palestinians and Muslims.

The correlation between this tolerance and the pro-racism approach adopted by Australian Zionist leadership, both within peak and lobby organisations and political offices, is also explored.

AMAN has a history of documenting dehumanising material in far-right groups, and this report continues our commitment to exposing injustice wherever it exists. It is crucial to note that the group under scrutiny comprises members from both ends of the political spectrum, and included some non-Jewish members who appeared strongly Zionist in outlook. AMAN acknowledges that the overwhelming majority of the Zionist movement worldwide is comprised of non-Jews.

While there was no explicit "anti-Zionist" ideology observed during the period under review (Nov 2023 to March 2024), hostility towards individuals advocating for ceasefire or the inclusion of pro-Palestinian perspectives was prevalent. Counter and moderating speech is included in this report. Furthermore there was regular blending of online and offline actions of the group.

We approached this report with caution, mindful of the potential to exacerbate antisemitism. As an anti-racism body, we condemn the essentialising and smearing of entire communities. Our commitment to principled anti-racism work is unwavering, and we have collaborated with anti-racism partners within the Jewish community to ensure the responsible dissemination of this report.

## ANTI-PALESTINIAN RACISM

The Arab Canadian Lawyer's Association report proposes the following "description" of anti-Palestinian racism:

Anti-Palestinian racism is a form of anti-Arab racism that silences, excludes, erases, stereotypes, defames or dehumanizes Palestinians or their narratives.

Anti- Palestinian racism takes various forms including:

- Denying the Nakba and justifying violence against Palestinians;
- Failing to acknowledge Palestinians as an Indigenous people with a collective identity, belonging and rights in relation to occupied and historic Palestine;
- Erasing the human rights and equal dignity and worth of Palestinians;
- Excluding or pressuring others to exclude Palestinian perspectives, Palestinians and their allies;
- Defaming Palestinians and their allies such as being inherently antisemitic, a terrorist threat/sympathizer or opposed to democratic values.

## DEHUMANISING MATERIAL

Dehumanising material is the material produced or published, which an ordinary person would conclude, portrays the class of persons identified on the basis of a protected characteristic ("class of persons") as not deserving to be treated equally to other humans because they lack qualities intrinsic to humans. Dehumanising material includes portraying the class of persons:

- a. To be, or have the appearance, qualities, or behaviour of
  - i. An animal, insect, filth, form of disease or bacteria;
  - ii. Inanimate or mechanical objects; or
  - iii. A supernatural alien or demon.
- b. Are polluting, despoiling, or debilitating an ingroup or society as a whole:
- c. Have a diminished capacity for human warmth and feeling or to make up their own mind, reason or form their own individual thoughts;
- d. Homogeneously pose a powerful threat or menace to an in-group or society, posing overtly or deceptively;
- e. Are to be held responsible for and deserving of collective punishment for the specific crimes, or alleged crimes of some of their "members";
- f. Are inherently criminal, dangerous, violent or evil by nature;
- g. Do not love or care for their children;
- h. Prey upon children, the aged, and the vulnerable;
- i. Was subject as a group to past tragedy or persecution that should now be trivialised, ridiculed, glorified or celebrated;
- j. Are inherently primitive, coarse, savage, intellectually inferior or incapable of achievement on a par with other humans;
- k. Must be categorised and denigrated according to skin colour or concepts of racial purity or blood quantum; or
- I. Must be excised or exiled from public space, neighbourhood or nation.

AMAN has also analysed over 100 instances of anti-Palestinian and anti-Muslim racism in a Facebook group with 8,900 members between November 2023 and March 2024. We observed:

- A failure to acknowledge Palestinians as an Indigenous people with a collective identity, belonging and rights in relation to occupied and historic Palestine;
- ii. Israel's violence against Palestinians was justified or denied, erasing the human rights and equal dignity and worth of Palestinians; and
- iii. Anti-Muslim conspiracy theory was shared unchallenged in the group;
- iv. Defaming Palestinians and their allies as terroristic and a danger to democracy.

Unfortunately, these patterns are reflected at a higher level.

The Australian Jewish Association published a video portraying the crowd as chanting "Gas the Jews", which sparked national and international media coverage to characterise the Palestinian protests at the Opera House as Anti-Semitic. The video was later found to be false.<sup>2</sup> As JCA Executive Director Schwartz states, "It is concerning the government swiftly reacted to an alleged chant without proper evidence. It shows the government isn't making rational decisions about these issues."<sup>3</sup>

Peter Wertheim, CEO of the Executive Council of Australian Jewry (ECAJ), described the pro-Palestinian movement as a combination of 'Islamist extremists' and 'Western progressives' who have a 'shared hatred Western liberal democracy.'4

Alex Ryvchin, other CEO of ECAJ, speaking of Gazan refugees coming to Australia, also reframes grievance with Israel through the lens of anti-Semitism: "I think there's a greater concern about the worldview, the values that these people hold, and are they compatible with Australian values and living alongside a Jewish community that they've been raised to hate?".

Lawyer and National Chairman of the Australia/Israel Jewish Affairs Council, Mark Liebler AC, said on the QandA program, "When it comes to terrorists, do you see Jews walking around with banners saying, "Destroy Hamas, destroy Hamas"? They don't do it.... This is not something which is in line with Jewish tradition. And what do the Palestinians do? Whether it's 9/11 or 7 October, they hand out lollies, and they celebrate when people are hacked to death." Mr Nasser Mashni, the President of APAN who was on the panel, said, "he's besmirched our entire people."

These comments from persons in positions of responsibility essentialise and dehumanise all Palestinians via imputation of a terrorist connection. This deliberate strategy sadly works to activate Australian prejudice and disarm rational thinking.<sup>7</sup>

Henry Ergas, an economist, uses the term "Islamist theological Antisemitism," which echoed Mr Wertheim's message. However, this term may confuse and lead to greater difficulties by associating the issue with Islamist theology. It is like the conflation of Israel and its

actions with Antisemitism. These politically motivated attempts to tie Palestinian resistance to undefined and demonising concepts work hand in hand with suggesting that all Jewish people are Zionists and support Israel. Both exacerbate racism and need to be comprehensively rejected.

There has been a broader editorial push in Newscorp papers<sup>8</sup> to suggest that Islam and Muslims are the problem. In one piece dated 25 October 2023<sup>9</sup>, Alex Ryvchin (ECAJ), Robert Gregory (Australian Jewish Association) and Jeremy Leibler (Zionist Federation of Australia) took turns making comments about the Australian Muslim leadership and community:

- i. "I am unaware of a single Muslim cleric in this country who has unreservedly condemned the atrocities which included beheading babies, raping young girls and murdering Holocaust survivors," said Mr Gregory, repeating discredited atrocity propaganda by the Israeli Defence Force.
- ii. Mr Gregory continues, "the majority have remained silent. Their silence speaks for itself and is an indictment on Australia's approach to immigration and multiculturalism".
- iii. Mr Gregory engages in dehumanisation by attempting to depict Muslims as inherently dangerous and violent and proposes to apply to Muslims some form of exclusion or exile: "There is nothing to talk about with those who cannot separate their religion from terrorism."
- iv. Mr Ryvchin states, "This is a battle of humanity against barbarism." It is noted at this stage that already thousands of civilians had been murdered by Israel's indiscriminate bombing, and the whole of Gaza had been subject to a siege of food, water, fuel and medical supplies.
- v. Lawyer and Zionist Federation of Australia spokesperson
  Jeremy Leibler excuses any legal responsibility for Israel of
  indiscriminate bombing and the crime of the total siege, saying,
  'Muslim leaders ought to condemn Hamas for bringing this
  upon their own people.'

Australia Israel & Jewish Affairs Council executive director Colin Rubenstein said it was "very telling and disappointing that the Foreign Minister could not unequivocally welcome the remarkable rescue of the four Israeli hostages". Dr Rubenstein said the rescue complied with international law and "Hamas casualty figures for the rescue were undoubtedly overstated". Senator Wong would not say whether rescuing the hostages was worth the Palestinian casualties, amid claims that 274 Palestinian civilians were killed in the operation. Pushing public figures to glorify or celebrate tragedies and alleged war crimes, and trivialising, ridiculing numbers of Palestinian deaths is an overt form of dehumanisation.

Regrettably, most of Australia's leading Jewish organisations have failed to condemn explicit and implicit racism about Palestinians and Muslims and instead run a false campaign through the media that Australian Muslim organisations tolerate hatred towards Jews and approve of atrocities. This "accusation in the mirror" is a technique<sup>10</sup> to allow harmful behaviours towards the Palestinian and Muslim communities to

continue to fly under the radar and flourish.

The Jewish Council of Australia and other groups like Loud Jew Collective and Tzedek have provided a consistent and strong voice against dehumanising and discriminatory messaging.

Zionist proponents in political office have also engaged in similar characterisations of the Palestinian and Muslim community, which also has a broader social effect on the Australian public. AMAN has observed a relaxation in social regulation of anti-Muslim and anti-Arab racism, with people feeling more at ease to express dehumanising views in shared online spaces and facing less regulation from others online for doing so.

The Albanese Labor Government has appointed Jilian Segal, former President of the Executive Council of Australian Jewry, who was ultimately responsible for the comments of Mr Rvychin and Mr Wertheim (noted above), to be Australia's first Antisemitism Envoy.

We note that the Government has also announced an intention to appoint an Islamophobia Envoy, a move that both APAN and AMAN have expressed objections and concern with for principled reasons. Ms Segal supports Israel's military efforts despite the International Court of Justice Advisory Opinion of 19 July 2024 and the provisional measures under the Genocide Convention announced since 26 January 2024. We consider it inappropriate for someone to be appointed to an antiracism, nationally funded role that encourages support for unlawful state conduct in grave violation of human rights. Further evidence is provided below.

On 30 November 2023, Ms Segal wrote, "And our local war is just beginning. We must understand that we, as the representatives of this community, have obligations. We are here to fight for the rights and freedoms of our people, to defend Israel from disinformation and slander that ultimately is paid for in Jewish lives." 12

Following Penny Wong's comments in support of a ceasefire and condemning the bombing of hospitals, in November 2023, it was reported, "On the call, Jeremy Leibler, a Melbourne lawyer and president of the Zionist Federation, and Executive Council president Jillian Segal argued the time had come for Jewish leaders to criticise Wong publicly. ... Everyone on the call agreed that Leibler and Segal would issue a statement saying they were "highly concerned" by Wong's comments." <sup>13</sup>

In response to actors wearing the Kefiyeh on stage in solidarity with Palestinians, acknowledging that Palestinians are human beings that have the right to exist and be treated with dignity like everyone else, Ms Segal states, "Theatre is intended to enrich and uplift us, and unite us through the shared love of the art form. It is not the place to impose the political views of a few onto the many or to marginalise Jewish audiences and actors." 14

It was reported that "President of the Executive Council of Australian Jewry, Jillian Segal, told the crowd the war should continue until Hamas was destroyed. "There can be no ceasefire until every hostage has been released," Ms Segal said, as the crowd cheered in response. She said all Jewish people wanted peace in the Middle East. "One cannot make peace with those who deny one's right to exist," she said." Ms Segal would be aware that Israel has had multiple opportunities to secure

the release of the hostages via negotiation and exchange with Palestinian hostages. Her rhetoric seems to justify and promote support for Israel's conduct to continue in Gaza, in contradiction with human rights law.<sup>15</sup>

Ms Segal has argued for Palestinian Australian Nasser Mashni, from APAN, not to have a voice in Q&A.<sup>16</sup> This was not the first time she has tried to suppress Palestinian perspectives receiving airtime. Ms Segal, in her role as ECAJ president, also lobbied ABC in 2021 to minimise Palestinian voices.<sup>17</sup>

Ms Segal has opposed the Australian Government labelling Palestinian territories as Occupied in line with international law, thereby denying the occupation and Palestinian people's legally protected status as occupied peoples. In a joint statement, Zionist Federation of Australia president Jeremy Leibler and Executive Council of Australian Jewry president Jillian Segal called the change in language "inaccurate, ahistorical and counterproductive". "Describing the territories as 'Palestinian' not only preempts the outcome of negotiations but is counterproductive," they said.<sup>18</sup>

Ms Segal has actively called for formal endorsement of the IHRA definition of Antisemitism, which includes criticism of Israel in some circumstances as being Antisemitic, nullifying and infringing the human rights of Palestinians in Australia. <sup>19</sup> On the IHRA and the Jerusalem Definition, Ms Segal states, "we must resist" the Jerusalem Definition of Antisemitism because "it specifically recognises what antisemitism is not, including BDS [Boycott, Divest, Sanction], including criticism of Israel, etc." Ms Segal then turns to Ms Allegra Spender, Teals Member for Wentworth, who is also a speaker on the same panel, and says that Ms Spender should not only promote the IHRA definition but promote 'non-acceptance' of the Jerusalem definition of Antisemitism.<sup>20</sup>

Ms Segal has promoted the Jewish community in Australia as singularly Zionist and supportive of Israel's conduct, thereby essentialising Jewish Australians as interchangeable and monolithic in their political views. This is dehumanising to Jewish Australians.<sup>21</sup>



Anti-Palestinian racism includes defaming Palestinians and their allies as being inherently antisemitic, a terrorist threat or sympathiser, and opposed to democratic values. Numerous artefacts document offline and onlinelocal activity to 'correct', 'cover up' or pressure to remove billboard signs, stickers, posters and graffiti to 'Free Palestine', 'Boycott Israel', 'Ceasefire now', which are described as 'hate'.

The Palestinian flag, which is banned from display in Israel in public places, is described as making Jewish Australians 'unsafe' ('Is this acceptable in Australia? Can it be reported or condemned?").

An older Australian who put a Palestinian flag in the front garden of the Castlemaine RSL with a sign that says "Bendigo Against Genocide" was photographed and asked to remove the flag by a contributor to the group (he refused). The contributor refers to the person's group as about to start a 'hate rally'.

Posters saying, 'You're not an activist, you're not a liberal. You're just a [expletive] antisemite' and 'always remember antisemitism doesn't help Palestinians' are produced and shared via the group to 'cover up the hate'. Examples are shown of these posters covering posters of a watermelon saying, 'Free Palestine' and 'Boycott Israel'.

In another incident, graffiti saying 'Israel is guilty of war crimes' is described as hate speech.

Another contributor writes about a visit to the Immigration Museum with his two young daughters when he complained about a child's poster and successfully asked for it to be removed in the kids activity section. The picture is of a T-shirt and bag inscribed with the words '#Free Palestine', 'From the river to the sea' and 'Stop the Genocide' and responds to a Museum prompt, 'What is important to you? Design your own T-shirt and tote bag that proudly show your values to the world.' This contributor is widely congratulated for having it taken down, with responses about 'learned hate' and 'unfortunately they don't know any better. They are raised on hatred'.

Another contributor shares that when at the public pool she saw a university student wearing a 'keffiah' (Palestinian scarf) ('I went in with how much I care about the death and destruction. I asked why she wore the scarf. She wanted Palestinian people to understand that she was a safe person to approach. She was horrified to learn that currently the keffiah has a similar threatening effect as the swastika for Jews. That by wearing it, Jewish people will be fearful and distrusting of her. I asked her not to wear it at the pool, where I bring my kids, and she agreed.') This post received overwhelming support.

This was the most prolific form of racism and it received overwhelming support in the group and comparatively, very minor challenge.







It took 90 years to ban the swastika and associated symbols of that tyranny but it was eventually banned as a reminder of an abhorrent reign of a fascist dictatorship. The Palestinian flag is a symbol of Palestinian self determination. And the Palestinians (in their own right) are NOT a terrorist organisation. Hamas flags however present a different arrangement of repression, tyranny and destruction. From a Palestinian perspective, the star and stripes of Israel represent 75 years of repression and occupation. What should the Palestinians do when they see blue stripes glued to lamp posts. Coins have TWO sides.

It's sickening. All it's doing is inciting

violence and anti-Semitism.

If a state must be a thing at all, then a single binational state without one group having control over another is the only way forward. Take a leaf out of Martin Buber's book for this solution.


I will continue to live in the diaspora that has existed since the Assyrian exile because I feel safer in diaspora and have no connection or loyalty to nation states or borders.
