Do you support or oppose settlements?

More coalition supporters oppose than support settlements built on Palestinian land

Do you support immediate recognition of the state of Palestine?

49% support recognition of Palestine and only 13% oppose recognition – nearly four times as many people support as oppose

Do you support the immediate end or continuation of the occupation?

47% of coalition voters support an immediate end to the occupation of Palestine by Israel while only 14% support the continuation of the occupation. That's more than 3 times as many support an immediate end to the occupation as support its continuation.

Should the govt support the ICC investigation into war crimes in Palestine?

56% of the coalition supporters think Australian govt should support the ICC investigation into war crimes committed in Palestine while only 15% oppose supporting the investigation. That's nearly 4 times as many coalition supporters think the Australian govt should support rather than oppose the ICC investigation.

Was the force used in the Israeli military attacks on Gaza in May 2021 justified?

45% of coalition voters think the force used and damage done in Israeli attacks on Gaza last May were not justified. Only 20% think the force used in the attacks was justified.

Should the siege of Gaza immediately end or continue?

A majority of coalition supporters (54%) think the siege of Gaza should immediately end while only 14% think it should continue.

Apartheid

54% of the coalition supporters take the findings by HR organisations that Israel is practising apartheid seriously and want the govt to act. Only 19% think Australia should stay a staunch ally of Israel.

Boycotts

Nearly three times as many coalition voters (45%) see boycotts of Israel as reasonable than see them as unreasonable (16%)

One state

If the two state solution is not viable then 40% of Coalition voters think moving to one state with equal rights for Israelis and Palestinians is the best way forward while only 16% think the status quo is the best way forward. That is 2 and half times as many coalition supporters would support a one state solution rather than the status quo.

Poll was conducted by YouGov in March 2022 with just over 1013 respondents weighted to represent the community with a margin of error of + or - 3.5%
