66% of ALP voters think the Australian govt should support the ICC investigation into war crimes committed in Palestine while only 8% oppose supporting the investigation.

58% of ALP voters think the force used and damage done in Israeli attacks on Gaza last May were not justified. Only 13% think the force used in the attacks was justified.

A large majority of ALP voters (63%) think the siege of Gaza should immediately end while only 8% think it should continue.

Nearly three times as many coalition voters (45%) see boycotts of Israel as reasonable than see them as unreasonable (16%).

If the two state solution is not viable then 45% of ALP voters think moving to one state with equal rights for Israelis and Palestinians is the best way forward while only 16% think the status quo is the best way forward.
