The vast majority of Coalition, ALP and Greens voters see boycotts of Israel as reasonable response to the Israeli occupation of Palestine.

One state

If the two state solution is not viable then between 40-45% of Coalition, ALP and Greens voters think moving to one state with equal rights for Israelis and Palestinians is the best way forward while only 9-16% think the status quo is the best way forward.
